Overview, Target Audience and Learner Outcome

This conference is for interdisciplinary healthcare team members caring for adolescent pediatric patients in a variety of settings. As a result of this session, learners will be able to apply new knowledge related to pediatric specialty practice in order to provide current, evidence-based practice care to pediatric populations.
