

Course Description

The Women's Health Symposium will provide current clinical information in aspects of health/wellness specific to women. The symposium will utilize didactic sessions that will include decision making and management, and interactive techniques utilizing audience response systems. The targeted audience is Physicians, Nurse Practitioners, Physician's Assistants, and allied health professionals involved in the care of women.

Course objectives

- Gain awareness of potential mental health issues during and after pregnancy. Review how treatment for Substance-Use Disorder may impact pregnancy and infancy and how to connect a patient to services.
- Recognize the warning signs and causes of obstetric hemorrhage and the role of surgical management. Appreciate the special care involved in the management of abnormal placentation.
- Review the history of mesh use in surgery and the problems associated with vaginal mesh use in pelvic reconstructive procedures. Discuss treatment options for patients experiencing complications.
- Define Human Trafficking and discuss risk factors for victimization. Review national and local statistics and local response to Human Trafficking Victims. Review recent literature on Human Trafficking and focus of medical research. Discuss the victim identification tool and be comfortable with its use.
- Recognize the types of prevention and the risk factors for ovarian cancer. Review the role of genetic screening in identifying risk. Recognize the special care involved in the management of patients with BRCA mutations.
- Review the diagnosis and treatment of multiple sclerosis. Review reproductive issues and multiple sclerosis.
- Describe the function of Von Willebrand factor and its hemostatic role. Utilize diagnostic workup and subtypes. Employ pretreatment testing and management strategies. Classify common presentations of VWD in obstetrics and gynecology.
- Recognize the different types of constipation. Identify the magnitude of the problem. Apply a systematic approach to diagnosing the type of constipation. Outline the different treatments for the separate subtypes.
- Discuss health concerns of morbid obesity and insurance requirements for surgery. Describe how to approach the morbidly obese patient. Discuss lifestyle change and medical optimization. Describe the operations and post-operative care.

Accreditation

Application for CME credit has been filed with the Academy of Family Physicians. Determination of credit is pending.
